- 1. What I know.
- 2. What the author told me to draw a conclusion about the author's intentions.

When I identify the Main Idea, I...

- Think about what I know about my topic.
- Draw a conclusion about what the author wants me to know.
- Ask myself, what would the author say is most important?
- Put this all together to get the MAIN IDEA!
