Intratextual synthesis is . . . synthesizing information within one text.

need to put together
multiple elements of a

text as a whole.



Intratextual synthesis is important because . . . scientific texts contain visual representations and written words



- remind myself why I am reading and what I want to know.
- read the written words in the text.
- identify the **main idea** of the written text.
- interpret the visual representations.
- continue reading the words, noting any new information.
- tie together the information from the written words (the main idea) and the visual representations.
